In her 2017 podcast series **Fractured Ground**, she documented women in Detroit reclaiming agency through self-identification as “unapologetically autonomous,” a phrase that would later echo in the **“I belong to me”** mantra. Yet the phrase crystallized unexpectedly during a 2020 virtual summit on digital identity, hosted by a now-defunct transmedia collective advocating for “digital self-determination.” Rose, initially a skeptic, participated tentatively, sharing anonymized interviews with survivors of online harassment and algorithmic surveillance. A moment crystallized: a woman, unburdened by labels, declared, “I don’t need permission to exist—only recognition.” The crowd erupted; the image, stripped of context, was shared across platforms. Within 48 hours, the phrase had gone viral, stripped of its original nuance but amplified by a global audience grappling with the erosion of personal boundaries in

the digital era. This transformation from intimate testimony to cultural slogan reflects a deeper societal shift. The early 2020s marked a turning point in global public consciousness: the pandemic accelerated digital immersion, while economic precarity and political instability eroded trust in centralized institutions. Traditional narratives of identity—national, familial, corporate—were challenged by a rising ethos of individual sovereignty. **“I belong to me”** became a rallying cry not for isolation, but for reclaimed autonomy: a rejection of external definitions imposed by algorithms, governments, or social expectations. Geopolitically, the phrase resonated differently across regions. In Eastern Europe, particularly in countries with histories of authoritarian control—Poland, Ukraine, Belarus—it carried echoes of resistance against state surveillance and propaganda. Activists repurposed it in underground networks, framing self-ownership as a form of political defiance. In Latin America, where neoliberal reforms had deepened inequality, it fused with indigenous movements emphasizing ancestral sovereignty—where “belonging” was not to citizenship but to land, language, and lineage. Middle Eastern digital activists, operating under repressive regimes, adopted the phrase as a coded assertion of identity

amid state erasure, blending it with calls for free expression in encrypted forums. Economically, the rise of **"I belong to me"** paralleled the growth of the "gig economy" and decentralized finance (DeFi). As traditional employment contracts dissolved, millions turned to freelance platforms, crypto assets, and personal branding—spaces where identity became both currency and shield. Rose's reporting highlighted how creators on Substack, OnlyFans, and Patreon weaponized the phrase: not as a rejection of community, but as a declaration of ownership over labor, narrative, and data. "You no longer belong to the platform," one influencer put it. "You own your story." This reframing challenged corporate ownership models and catalyzed new forms of digital labor rights activism. Industry impact was immediate and multifaceted. Media organizations, once gatekeepers of narrative legitimacy, faced pressure to cede authority. Newsrooms began experimenting with "participatory journalism," inviting audience co-creation—what Rose termed a "democratization of voice." Yet this shift exposed tensions: how to balance authenticity with accountability when personal testimony fuels virality. Academics noted a paradox: the phrase championed individual sovereignty while thriving on mass dissemination, often divorced from

its original context. Social media algorithms, designed to amplify emotional resonance, turned introspection into spectacle—what Rose described as “the commodification of vulnerability.” Experts cautioned against oversimplification. In India, amid rising digital surveillance and caste-based discrimination, it surfaced in underground forums as a tool for marginalized identities to assert presence without assimilation. The long-term implications are profound. Rose's ongoing research suggests *"I belong to me"* may evolve into a foundational principle of 21st-century identity—less about withdrawal, more about strategic sovereignty. It challenges institutions—state, corporate, social—to recognize individual agency not as anomaly, but as norm. Future governance models may need to integrate personalized autonomy: digital identity systems that prioritize user control, decentralized verification, and consent-based data ownership. Economically, this shift accelerates demand for tools that enable self-sovereign identity—blockchain-based

credentials, encrypted personal data vaults, and peer-to-peer reputation networks. The creative economy, already decentralized, will deepen this trend: artists, writers, and thinkers increasingly operate outside traditional hierarchies, treating identity as both brand and boundary. Looking forward, Rose envisions a world where the phrase becomes less a slogan and more a lens: a framework for navigating complexity. “It’s not about isolation,” she explains. “It’s about choosing who you engage with, on your terms—while remaining open to connection, when it serves you. That balance, not rigid individualism, will define resilience.” Yet risks remain. Over-identification with self can erode empathy; unchecked autonomy may fragment collective action. The challenge lies in cultivating sovereignty without solipsism—honoring personal truth while engaging the world. As Rose concludes, *“I belong to me”* is not an endpoint, but a beginning: a probe into the evolving relationship between self, society, and systems in an age of profound transformation.
