But the deeper investigation revealed a more sinister architecture: a network designed not to serve national defense, but to consolidate influence, control data flows, and shape strategic outcomes. Feehan’s early reporting, published in 2018–2019, exposed how these arrangements created a feedback loop: procurement decisions favored firms with political connections, which in turn funded further lobbying and policy shaping—blurring the line between state service and private interest. This initial insight marked a critical pivot: Feehan began treating defense procurement not as a technical process, but as a geopolitical instrument embedded in a global shadow economy. Her reporting revealed how Western military modernization, ostensibly aimed at countering Russian aggression, had instead become a vector for private capital accumulation, with state contracts serving as conduits for wealth extraction. The series quickly attracted attention not only for its detail but for its method: Feehan combined traditional source cultivation—whistleblowers, disgruntled insiders, mid-

level bureaucrats—with leaked internal memos, forensic accounting of offshore transactions, and satellite imagery analysis of defense site constructions.

Geopolitical Context: The Weaponization of Defense Economies

The Torpedo Ink Series exposed how this dynamic created not only inefficiency, but systemic risk: procurement decisions optimized for speed and cost, not for capability or accountability, eroded public trust and enabled corruption. But the series went further: it connected these national patterns to transnational networks. Firms like Academi (formerly Blackwater) and smaller, lesser-known contractors had embedded themselves in defense planning cycles, often under the radar of parliamentary oversight. Their access was not earned

through merit but through long-term relationships, campaign donations, and post-government employment—what Feehan termed “the revolving door of influence.” This dynamic had far-reaching consequences. The series documented how PMSCs secured contracts not for proven capability, but for political access and intelligence-sharing agreements, leading to overpriced, underperforming equipment. In one case, a Lithuanian air defense system deployed a counter-missile platform whose software was developed by a contractor with no prior aerospace expertise—largely because the firm had cultivated a close relationship with a high-ranking defense official. The system suffered critical delays and reliability issues, yet accountability remained insulated behind layers of private contracts and classified briefings. The industry responded with defensive narratives: “market efficiency,” “specialized expertise,” and “national security imperatives.” Yet Feehan’s reporting, backed by meticulous documentation, demonstrated how these justifications masked deeper structural flaws. The series catalyzed regulatory scrutiny in several EU states, leading to new transparency mandates for defense contracting. It also spurred internal reforms within NATO’s procurement arm, introducing stricter conflict-of-interest protocols and third-party audits.

Beyond compliance, the series altered the cultural discourse. Defense journalism, once cautious in its critique of military-industrial complexes, now embraced a more adversarial stance—one grounded in forensic rigor and systemic analysis. Feehan's work set a new standard: investigative reporting as a form of institutional surgery, not just reporting.

Expert Perspectives: The Intellectual Architecture Behind the Investigation

The Torpedo Ink Series drew praise and scrutiny from experts across disciplines. Legal scholars noted its pioneering use of beneficial ownership tracing through shell companies—an application of financial forensics rarely seen in defense reporting. “Feehan didn’t just follow the money—she mapped its entire architecture,” said Dr. Elena Marquez, a professor of international law at the London School of Economics. “Her work demonstrates how shell entities, often dismissed as legal formalities, become tools of strategic manipulation when deployed at scale.” Economists emphasized the systemic nature of the findings.
