These structured tools, often dismissed in earlier eras as simplistic or rote exercises, now stand at the forefront of cognitive development strategies, shaped by decades of research, geopolitical educational reforms, and an urgent demand for discerning minds in an age of information saturation. The origins of formal critical thinking instruction in primary education are rooted in post-war cognitive psychology and the Cold War's intellectual imperatives. During the mid-20th century, as nations competed not only in military and economic domains but in ideological influence, the U.S. and Soviet blocs alike recognized the strategic value of cultivating analytical reasoning from early childhood. The 1956 publication of *The Thinking School** by educational theorists like Robert Enos and Jerome Bruner laid foundational principles for scaffolding reasoning skills, emphasizing inquiry-based learning over passive absorption. Though not yet labeled “worksheets,” these early frameworks introduced structured questioning, logical sequencing, and reflective prompts—precursors to today’s worksheet design.
