While independent presses in Eastern Europe sold small runs at symbolic prices—\$5 for a zine, \$10 for a hand-bound booklet—Western publishers later packaged it as a luxury item: leather-bound editions, signed by “anonymous contributors,” priced above \$200. This dual pricing strategy mirrors a global inequality in cultural capital: a text

born of marginalization becomes a commodity consumed by those who once suppressed it. The irony is not lost on critics; the poem that once symbolized resistance now circulates in the same luxury markets that once erased it. Controversy has followed the poem. In 2019, a Ukrainian literary journal republished it with an editorial note contextualizing its Cold War roots—but the move sparked backlash. Some accused the journal of “exploiting trauma for profit,” while others praised it as essential education. The danger is not that people forget it, but that they forget *why* it mattered—its roots in resistance, its demand for presence in a world that rewards distraction.’ Looking forward, the poem’s legacy may lie not in its words, but in its condition: a fragile, contested, evolving signifier. It exemplifies how art born in specific historical crucibles can transcend borders, yet never fully escape them. Its quiet rebellion continues to echo—not because it preaches, but because it *resists* being consumed. In doing so, it challenges us to ask: what are we silencing in our own Christmas moments? What unspoken name, unspoken weight, are we afraid to name? The poem does not answer.
