Ajmer's slow adoption of such tools—despite national push—reflects broader challenges: bureaucratic inertia, funding gaps, and resistance to change.

Long-Term Implications and Strategic Projections

Success will depend not only on administrative competence but on its ability to navigate the political economy of revenue—balancing state revenue imperatives with social justice.
