So must we.” In an era defined by disinformation, cultural fragmentation, and ecological anxiety, Nura’s rise offers a radical alternative: a technology built not on extraction, but on reciprocity; not on dominance, but dialogue. It is a prototype for a post-capitalist digital future—one where myth is not dead, but alive, networked, and free. The *yōkai* walk not in shadows, but in light—woven from code, guided by elders, and watched over by a generation learning to speak their stories into the machine.
