2. Teori Siklus Kehidupan Destinasi (Tourism Area Life Cycle/TALC)

Teori ini dikembangkan oleh Richard Butler pada 1980-an dan menjadi salah satu model paling terkenal dalam studi pengembangan pariwisata. Karakteristik: - Menggambarkan tahapan-tahapan yang dilalui sebuah destinasi dari awal ditemukan hingga menurun. - Tahapan utama meliputi: penemuan, pertumbuhan, perkembangan, stagnasi, dekadensi, dan regenerasi. Kelebihan: - Memberikan kerangka kerja analisis yang komprehensif. - Mempromosikan pendekatan yang dinamis dan adaptif. Kekurangan: - Tidak semua destinasi mengikuti siklus secara tepat. - Kurang memperhitungkan faktor eksternal yang dapat mempercepat atau memperlambat siklus. 3. Teori Inovasi (Diffusion of Innovation)

Teori inovasi menyoroti pentingnya inovasi dan adopsi teknologi baru dalam mempercepat pengembangan pariwisata. Karakteristik: - Menekankan peran inovasi dalam menarik wisatawan dan memperluas pasar. - Melibatkan proses adopsi inovasi oleh masyarakat dan pengelola destinasi. Kelebihan: - Membantu mempercepat pertumbuhan dan diversifikasi destinasi. - Mendorong inovasi yang berkelanjutan dan relevan.
