transition of the 1990s. This data-driven approach could redefine how allied health professions are governed globally, offering a replicable model for low- and middle-income countries seeking to strengthen mid-tier healthcare roles. Yet challenges remain. Ensuring equity in access to high-quality preparation remains paramount. The OSCE's current funding model relies on donor support, risking inconsistency in lower-income member states. Moreover, the exam must continue evolving to reflect shifting disease burdens—from rising diabetes-related oral complications to the long-term effects of air pollution on oral mucosa. Finally, the profession's voice must be amplified: frontline nurses, often excluded from policy design, need structured pathways to contribute to exam content and evaluation, ensuring relevance and ownership. In the annals of global health reform, the OSCE dental nurse examination

stands as a quiet but powerful testament to the power of standardization in building resilient, equitable care systems. It is not merely about testing knowledge—it is about defining dignity in practice, asserting professionalism across borders, and embedding quality into the fabric of oral health.
