Lewis's proposal stands out for its early, systematic attempt to reconcile linguistic modernity with cultural authenticity, offering a template for nations navigating similar transitions. Expert projections highlight the long-term implications. Linguists such as David Graddol, in his longitudinal studies on English as

a global lingua franca, note that linguistic reforms in former colonies are increasingly shaping the character of English itself—moving toward decentralized, adaptive forms. Lewis’s work prefigured this trend: he believed English should evolve from within, shaped by its speakers’ needs, not imposed from above. His emphasis on clarity and inclusivity aligns with emerging paradigms in global English education, where communicative competence, intercultural sensitivity, and digital literacy are prioritized
