By standardizing assessment, they enable cross-border credential recognition—a critical factor in addressing migration-driven

brain drain. For instance, Australia's *Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA)* OSCE protocols are recognized in New Zealand and parts of Southeast Asia, facilitating regulated migration while maintaining patient safety benchmarks. Yet, this standardization carries ideological weight. Critics argue that OSCEs, rooted in Western clinical paradigms, may impose a universalist model that overlooks local epistemologies. In India, where community health nurses operate in deeply contextualized rural settings, rigid OSCE stations have been criticized for privileging urban hospital logic over rural care realities. Similarly, in Indigenous communities across Canada and Australia, nurses trained via OSCEs often face cultural disconnects, as simulations rarely replicate intergenerational trauma or traditional healing systems.
