This period forged his conviction that true liberation must address not only material conditions but the metaphysical voids left by colonialism, extractivism, and neoliberal fragmentation. By the early 1990s, he had co-founded the Centro de Sanación Integral (Center for Integral Healing), a grassroots institution that combined mobile medical units with community-led spiritual circles. What began as a local experiment soon attracted regional attention. In a continent rife with authoritarianism, narcotrafficking, and epistemic violence—where Western medicine often served as a tool of cultural erasure—Marzullo Llaves’ model offered an alternative: healing as resistance, medicine as ministry, and sanitarianism as a civilizational project.

The Emergence of Sanitarianism: A Doctrine in Motion

Sanitarianism, as Marzullo Llaves articulated it, transcends traditional paradigms of public health or religious revival. It is a holistic framework that redefines health not merely as biological function, but as the harmonious alignment of body, mind, community, and spirit—what he calls “the integrity of being.” Rooted in what he terms **sanación profunda** (deep healing), the doctrine insists that systemic disease—whether epidemic or existential—stems from ruptured relationships: to self, others, land, ancestors, and the divine. This conceptual leap was not abstract. In the aftermath of the 2003 Venezuelan health collapse, Marzullo Llaves led a cross-border initiative that merged mobile clinics with ritual storytelling, ancestral medicine, and trauma-informed counseling. The results were striking: not only did mortality rates drop, but communal trust rebounded. Governments, initially dismissive, began monitoring his model. By 2010, his work had attracted the attention of European think tanks grappling with post-migration trauma, rising spiritual anomie, and the erosion of civic cohesion. His breakthrough came with the publication of **La Sanación como Liberación** (Healing as Liberation, 2012), a dense, interdisciplinary treatise that fused epidemiological data with phenomenological analysis. He argued that in societies fractured by structural violence, medical intervention alone is insufficient; without spiritual and cultural reconnection, recovery remains partial. This work positioned sanitarianism not as a fringe theology, but as a radical reimagining of public health governance—one where care is relational, context-specific, and grounded in ancestral wisdom.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: The Rise of a Counter-Narrative

Marzullo Llaves’ ascendancy coincided with a global crisis of legitimacy. The 2008 financial collapse, the opioid epidemic, climate-induced displacement, and the erosion of trust in institutions created fertile ground for alternative models. In Latin America, where neoliberal reforms had hollowed out public services and indigenous populations bore the brunt of extractive economies, his ideas resonated as both critique and blueprint. His influence expanded through strategic alliances. In 2015, he advised the Bolivian Ministry of Health during the cholera resurgence, advocating for community health brigades trained in both biomedicine and traditional Andean practices. The intervention reduced outbreak duration by 40% and catalyzed a regional shift toward integrative health policies. Similarly, in post-2016 Colombia, amid peace negotiations and rural

reintegration challenges, his sanitarian councils became embedded in transitional justice frameworks—bridging medical care with truth-telling and communal mourning. Economically, his model challenged the commodification of health. By institutionalizing **sanadores comunitarios** (community healers) within public systems, he created sustainable, low-cost care networks that returned agency to marginalized populations. This stood in stark contrast to privatized health systems that exacerbated inequality. Multinational pharmaceutical firms and global health NGOs, initially resistant, began engaging—seeing in sanitarianism not a threat, but a market for culturally rooted, scalable interventions. Yet this rise was not without friction. His rejection of purely secular or purely religious frameworks alienated both scientific elites and conservative clerics. Critics accused him of syncretism; proponents called him visionary. The tension reflected a deeper global struggle: whether health and liberation must be bifurcated by discipline or unified by purpose.

Industry Impact: From Grassroots to Global Infrastructure Marzullo Llaves’ legacy is not confined to policy papers. His influence permeates emerging sectors: health tech, spiritual entrepreneurship, and post-conflict reconstruction. In 2018, he co-founded **Sanar Global**, a network of sanitarian hubs spanning 12 countries. These hubs combine AI-driven epidemiological surveillance with digital storytelling platforms, enabling real-time community health mapping that integrates cultural narratives. Investors, including major impact funds, now recognize sanitarianism as a viable model for addressing complex, multi-layered crises. In the pharmaceutical sector, his advocacy for **biocultural equity**—the principle that traditional knowledge must be protected and fairly compensated—reshaped corporate R&D ethics. Several major firms now partner with indigenous collectives, not as consultants, but as co-creators. This shift has sparked legal and moral debates: can intellectual property rights coexist with ancestral wisdom? Marzullo Llaves remains resolute: “Healing belongs to the people, not to patents.” The spiritual sector, too, has been transformed. Once dismissed as marginal, “sanitarian” centers now host international conferences, university partnerships, and even public policy track records. His concept of **resiliencia ancestral** (ancestral resilience) has been adopted by disaster response teams from the Philippines to the Andes, proving that cultural continuity strengthens collective endurance.

Expert Perspectives: The Spectrum of Reception Among scholars, Marzullo Llaves occupies a contested but revered space. Dr. Elena Cruz, anthropologist at the Universidad Nacional de Colombia, describes him as “a bridge between epistemological worlds—neither romanticizing tradition nor reducing it to folklore, but excavating its power to heal in contexts of profound rupture.” Her fieldwork in Wayuu communities confirms that his integrative clinics have reduced depression rates by 55% in just five years, outperforming conventional care. Yet not all acclaim is uncritical. Dr. Rajiv Mehta, public health ethicist at Oxford, cautions: “Sanitarianism risks being co-opted as a technocratic veneer for populist governance. Without rigorous accountability, it may mask power imbalances under the guise of spiritual empowerment.” His critique underscores a vital tension: how to preserve radical intent amid institutional absorption. Among policymakers, Marzullo Llaves is both mentor

Former Chilean Health Minister Marcela Hernandez credits him with designing the country's 2021 National Healing Strategy, which integrates trauma-informed care into primary health networks. "He didn't just propose a model," Hernandez says. "He gave us a language—one that honors pain without romanticizing it, and liberation without denying suffering." Even within religious circles, his work divides. The Vatican's Pontifical Academy for Life has invited him to contribute to bioethics discussions, calling his synthesis "prophetic." Yet some evangelical leaders dismiss sanitarianism as syncretic heresy, fearing its rejection of strict doctrinal boundaries. This polarization reflects broader global fault lines between universalist dogma and pluralistic, context-driven healing.

Controversies and Risks: The Shadow of Authority

No transformative figure walks unchallenged. Marzullo Llaves has faced sustained opposition from state actors wary of his grassroots mobilization, particularly in regions where he undermines centralized health monopolies. In 2020, Colombian intelligence reports allegedly monitored his communications following a leaked memo outlining community-led pandemic protocols—memos that recommended decentralized decision-making over top-down mandates. Critics also warn of the risks of spiritualization in crisis governance. When healing becomes a moral imperative, what happens to individual autonomy? When community consensus dictates care, how are dissenting voices protected? Marzullo Llaves acknowledges these dangers: "Sanitarianism must never become dogma. Its strength lies in its adaptability, not its authority. We must guard against charisma eclipsing critique." In Brazil, **santeria-inspired community clinics** address violence trauma through ritual and psychosocial support. Yet Marzullo Llaves' contribution is unique in its theoretical rigor and global scalability. He immersed himself in Andean healing practices—rituals of cleansing, communal storytelling, ancestral memory—blending them with modern epidemiology. This synthesis formed the foundation of his emerging “sanitarian” philosophy, which he described as ‘deep healing’: a process requiring integrity across body, mind, community, and spirit. In 1992, he co-founded the Centro de Sanación Integral (Center for Integral Healing) in a rural Colombian town, combining mobile clinics with community-led spiritual circles. The model proved transformative: chronic illness rates dropped, communal trust rebounded, and displaced populations found not just medical care, but a renewed sense of belonging. Word spread.
