Critics argued that predictive models, trained on biased datasets, risked reinforcing stereotypes and enabling discriminatory tracking. The

incident catalyzed a global task force—spearheaded by the OECD and UNESCO—to draft ethical guidelines for AI in special education, emphasizing transparency, consent, and human oversight. Global comparisons underscored the uneven terrain. In Finland, the conference spotlighted a national model where inclusive education is embedded in teacher training from day one, with 98% of special needs students educated in mainstream schools supported by multidisciplinary teams. Yet even in resource-constrained settings, grassroots innovators were emerging: in Lagos, community-led “sensory hubs” trained local volunteers to support neurodiverse youth with low-cost tools, illustrating the power of frugal innovation. As Dr. Leila Haddad, a Moroccan advocate, concluded her keynote: “Inclusion is not a program. It is a choice—repeated, sustained, and shared across borders. The 2024 conferences were not an endpoint.
