The transition from DSM-III to DSM-5 (2013) accelerated this trend, incorporating neuroimaging data, genetic markers, and dimensional models. Yet, the core

This standardization, while enabling global consistency, also concentrated diagnostic authority in a single institution, raising questions about whose suffering is validated—and who is rendered invisible.

While many governments adopt it for alignment with global standards, local clinicians often report mismatches between DSM criteria and culturally embedded expressions of distress.
