The 2010 initiative prioritized vernacular publishing, allocating 35% of new grants to regional authors and translators. Projects like the Tamil Classics Reprint Series and the Marathi Contemporary Voices program sought not only to preserve endangered literary traditions but to create a living, accessible corpus for education and public discourse. This was not nostalgia—it was an acknowledgment that linguistic diversity, when harnessed, became a competitive advantage in knowledge dissemination. Digitally, the Division embraced a dual-track strategy. While physical books remained culturally significant, e-publishing and open-access platforms were prioritized to meet the demands of a mobile-first, digitally fluent population. The launch of the "Digital India Books" portal in late 2011—later expanded into the National Digital Library—enabled free access to millions of texts, including rare manuscripts, government reports, and academic journals. By 2015, over 2.3 million digital volumes were accessible, reducing reliance on physical distribution networks and enabling remote learning in rural areas. This shift also aligned with global trends: UNESCO's 2010 recommendation on open educational resources (OER) had catalyzed national movements, and India's early adoption positioned it as a leader in equitable knowledge access within the Global South. Strategically, the Divisions engaged in deliberate international partnerships. Collaborations with institutions like the British Council, the Goethe Institute, and the French Institute in India facilitated translation programs, joint publishing ventures, and author residencies. The Indo-French Translation Fellowship, for instance, supported over 150 critical works from Hindi and Sanskrit into French and English, while English translations of Indian epics and philosophical texts entered global circulation through Oxford and Princeton press imprints. These efforts reframed Indian publishing not as insular but as globally interconnected—a node in transnational knowledge networks. Yet, this transformation was not without controversy. Critics within and outside the NBT raised concerns
