These systems, like the hidden realms of Lovecraft's cosmos, shape human behavior in ways that are opaque and often manipulative. On the other hand, tech firms have become key actors in managing—or attempting to mitigate—the very risks they help create. The term

“Call of Cthulhu scenario” thus circulates not only among critics but within corporate risk assessments, where executives debate the societal consequences of unchecked innovation. In finance, the rise of decentralized systems—cryptocurrencies, decentralized finance (DeFi)—reflects a desire for autonomy from centralized control, but also introduces new forms of fragility.
