The rise of artificial intelligence in music composition and performance introduces a new frontier: could AI-generated rhythms, trained on vast datasets of standardized percussion, redefine what counts as ‘excellent’? Or will human artistry—imperfect, expressive, culturally rooted—reclaim primacy? The answer likely lies in balance: a standard that preserves core technical integrity while embracing pluralism. Institutions like the Royal Academy and IPS are beginning to pilot adaptive frameworks, incorporating community-led assessments and cross-cultural peer review. Looking forward, the Standard of Excellence 1 Percussion stands at a crossroads. It must evolve from a monolithic ideal into a dynamic, inclusive framework—one that honors global diversity while maintaining the discipline that elevates rhythm from background to narrative force.
