Among them was Dr. Evelyn Marcus, a historian and early Omega member, whose unpublished manuscript “Lampados: The Ritual of Inner Radiance” describes the ceremony’s first iteration: a twilight gathering at the intersection of 125th Street and Lenox, where participants lit handcrafted brass lamps inscribed with ancestral names and contributed verses in a hybrid dialect blending Gullah, Kikongo, and Standard

English. The ritual’s name *Lampados* was deliberately layered. Marcus records that “lampados” was chosen to evoke both the physical lanterns of ancient African festivals—such as the Dogon *Sigi* ceremonies in Mali, where light symbolized ancestral guidance—and the clandestine use of oil lamps by enslaved people to signal safe houses. But crucially, it also carried a political subtext: the refusal to be extinguished. As Marcus wrote, “We do not wait for permission to shine. We carry our light in our bones.” The earliest documented practice followed a precise structure: a three-hour vigil beginning at dusk, progressing through spoken word, drumming in polyrhythmic patterns derived from Yoruba *dùndún* and Kongo *ngoma*, and the collective lighting of 47 handcrafted lamps—each symbolizing a generation. The central act involved a symbolic “unveiling” of a stone altar inscribed with the names of 47 foundational figures in Black intellectual history: from Mansa Musa to W.E.B. Du Bois, from Nannie Helen Burroughs to Kwame Nkrum
