These flows are not merely demographic—they are structural. Nurses become mobile capital, recruited not as professionals but as labor to fill systemic voids. In the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) states, recruitment agencies—often with ties to private hospital chains—scour Southeast Asia and Eastern Europe, offering contracts with benefits far exceeding local wages. These nurses, though employed in wealthier nations, remain embedded in a transnational care hierarchy where their skills are extracted, their integration limited, and their mobility tightly controlled.
