By contrast, Syria's civil defense network, decimated by war,

operates at minimal capacity, revealing how conflict erodes institutional resilience. Even within democratic alliances, divergence persists. The U.S. maintains over 2,100 designated fallout shelters, mostly decommissioned but maintained under NIMS (National Incident Management System). Yet funding and public awareness lag—only 14% of Americans know the location of a nearby shelter, per a 2023 Pew Research survey. In Germany, public shelters are more integrated into urban planning, with 87% located within 500 meters of residential zones, supported by robust public education campaigns. These comparisons underscore a critical insight: shelter efficacy depends on state legitimacy, institutional continuity, and societal trust.
