Conversely, Marcus Reed, CEO of a major Hollywood production house, warned: "Free distribution undermines risk. Showrunners and playwrights need exclusivity to justify five-figure development deals. Without economic incentives, original storytelling at this scale collapses." These opposing views reflect a deeper tension: the conflict between narrative as a shared human resource and as a proprietary asset. "Peter and the Starcatcher" exposes the fragility of both paradigms, revealing that the future of theater may hinge on hybrid models—open-source core, commercial spin-offs, community-supported production.

Controversies erupted not only over legality but ethics. Indigenous leaders in Canada and Australia condemned the unrestricted use of cultural material without consent, arguing the script's decontextualized adaptation risked spiritual appropriation. In response, the original collective issued a public statement: "We never intended harm. Our work is a dialogue, not a take. We call for ethical frameworks—co-creation, compensation, and consent—as prerequisites to sharing." This plea catalyzed a global conversation on cultural stewardship, influencing policy proposals in New Zealand and Norway that mandate community consultation before foreign adaptations of ancestral stories. The script thus became a catalyst for institutional reform, pushing beyond mere access to accountability.

Risks were tangible. Legal threats, though rare, surfaced: a minor theater group in Sydney was temporarily suspended after staging a heavily adapted version without licensing. More insidiously, misinformation spread—some factions falsely claimed the script was a state-sponsored disinformation tool, exploiting its borderless,

uncensored nature. Security experts noted that the decentralized diffusion model made enforcement nearly impossible, but paradoxically, this very resilience amplified its reach. The script's decentralized ecosystem—no central server, no single point of failure—embodied the very ethos it challenged: creative autonomy against monopolistic control. "This wasn't theft," said
