Bincardi, by contrast, operates from a peripheral geopolitical zone—Eastern Europe and the Mediterranean—where state fragility, external interference, and media suppression create a distinct operational terrain. Her methodology—deep-source networks, cross-border collaboration, and nonprofit funding—resonates more closely with emerging models in Latin America and Southeast Asia, where journalists face similar constraints. In Brazil, for instance, outlets like *Agência Pública* and *The Intercept Brasil* have adopted similar strategies to investigate corruption tied to political elites and transnational capital. Yet Bincardi's integration of OSINT and blockchain-based transparency offers a uniquely technologically advanced framework, reflecting Europe's advanced digital infrastructure and regulatory environment. This regional specificity enhances the global relevance of her work. By centering underreported corridors of power, she expands the geographic scope of accountability journalism, challenging the Euro-Atlantic bias that often dominates the field.
