By the 1990s, post-apartheid reforms enabled institutional autonomy, and Khanyisa transitioned into an independent college. This shift coincided with South Africa’s broader health sector transformation, where the Department of Health prioritized expanding nursing capacity to meet the demands of a growing population, aging demographic, and persistent disease burden—particularly HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, and non-

communicable diseases. Over four decades, Khanyisa evolved from a community clinic training center into a publicly accredited higher education institution, accredited by the South African Council for Nursing and Midwifery (SACNM) in 2004. Its 2025 fee structure did not emerge in isolation; it reflected a complex interplay of historical investment, post-transition policy imperatives, and the structural economic pressures confronting public higher education in the Global South.

Geopolitical and Economic Context: The Pressures Shaping Khanyisa's 2025 Fee Framework

By 2025, Khanyisa Nursing School operated within a South African higher education ecosystem defined by fiscal austerity, inflationary strain, and systemic inequity. The national tertiary sector, already burdened by underfunding since the 2008 global financial crisis and exacerbated by COVID-19's disruption, faced acute challenges in maintaining accessibility while improving quality. The National Student Financial Aid System (NSFAS), the primary funding mechanism for low-income students, had expanded rapidly but struggled to keep pace with

rising operational costs—faculty salaries, clinical training infrastructure, safety equipment, and digital learning platforms. South Africa’s economy, mired in slow growth (averaging 0.8% GDP expansion from 2020–2024), constrained public expenditure. The Department of Higher Education and Innovation allocated only 1.2% of GDP to education in 2024—well below the 1.4% recommended by the World Bank for sustainable development. This fiscal reality forced institutions like Khanyisa to balance mission-driven inclusivity with financial survival. Moreover, the global nursing shortage—projected by the World Health Organization to reach 6 million vacancies by 2030—intensified competition for qualified graduates. In South Africa, this crisis was compounded by brain drain: skilled nurses migrated to high-income countries, while domestic institutions battled retention due to underpayment and poor working conditions. Khanyisa, serving a demographic of Black, rural, and low-income students, stood at the frontline—expected to produce competent practitioners despite systemic resource gaps. The 2025 fee policy thus emerged as a strategic negotiation: how to maintain affordability for its core cohort while securing sustainable funding to upgrade clinical facilities, expand faculty, and integrate emerging technologies like simulation-based

learning and telehealth training—all without inflating student debt beyond social tolerance.

2025 Fee Structure: Accessibility, Equity, and the Economics of Nursing Education

Khanyisa's 2025 fee framework was structured around three pillars: equity, transparency, and cost-recovery. Total annual tuition for a full four-year registered nursing program stood at R1.2 million (approximately USD \$66,000), a nominal increase from R1.05 million in 2023, adjusted for inflation and rising operational costs. This figure included mandatory student contribution fees, clinical training integration costs, and administrative overhead. NSFAS coverage remained central, with average grants rising to R680,000 annually—enough to support most low-income students, though remaining below the recommended R850,000 threshold needed to cover living and learning costs comprehensively. Private scholarships, institutional bursaries, and employer partnerships filled the gap, but coverage remained uneven. A 2024 audit revealed that only 43% of eligible students received full NSFAS support, leaving a significant portion reliant on personal savings or

informal loans—factors that directly impacted retention and completion rates. Notably, Khanyisa introduced a progressive fee model: students from historically disadvantaged areas (HDZs) qualified for up to 60% fee reduction, while those from more privileged provinces paid the standard rate. This geographic equity mechanism reflected a deliberate effort to reverse apartheid-era imbalances.

Additionally, a “learning outcome-based” fee discount program incentivized academic

performance—students achieving above 85% on mid-year assessments received up to R200,000 off subsequent semesters, aligning financial incentives with educational outcomes. The fee structure also accounted for clinical training, a major cost driver.

Khanyisa operated 12 affiliated hospitals across Gauteng and KwaZulu-Natal, paying clinical supervisors and simulation labs a fixed per-student rate. These partnerships ensured hands-on training but strained budgets: clinical service costs rose by 22% year-on-year due to inflation and increased student enrollment. To offset this, the school introduced a mandatory R40,000 clinical fees—waived for students receiving NSFAS support—blending cost-sharing with accessibility. Critics argued that despite these measures, R1.2 million remained prohibitive for

many families in provinces like Limpopo or the Eastern Cape, where average monthly incomes hover below R3,500. Others pointed to indirect costs—transport, textbooks, personal protection gear—that cumulatively exceeded R150,000 annually, effectively raising the total financial burden beyond tuition.

Economic and Industry Implications: Nursing as a Strategic National Asset

The stakes of Khanyisa’s 2025 fees extend beyond student wallets—they reflect a broader national strategy to build a resilient healthcare workforce. South Africa’s health system, strained by twin epidemics and demographic shifts, requires 400,000 new nurses by 2030. Yet current graduation rates hover around 35,000 annually—insufficient to meet demand. Khanyisa, as a public institution with a mandate to serve underserved regions, is both a feeder and a barometer for systemic reform. Economically, nursing education is increasingly viewed as a strategic investment. The World Bank’s 2024 report on human capital emphasized that every R1 invested in health workforce development yielded R4.30 in economic returns through improved

productivity and reduced disease burden. Khanyisa's fee policy, by lowering barriers to entry, directly contributes to this cycle—expanding the pipeline of locally rooted professionals who understand rural and township realities, reducing rural-urban migration, and enhancing retention. Yet the financial sustainability of nursing education remains precarious. Private nursing colleges with higher fees reported better retention and facility upgrades, but at the cost of exclusivity. Public institutions like Khanyisa, while accessible, risk quality erosion under underfunding. The 2025 fees represent a compromise: preserving mission while ensuring viability. However, without sustained public investment—targeted infrastructure funding, faculty salary reforms, and expanded scholarship pools—Khanyisa's model risks becoming a fragile equilibrium. Industry stakeholders, including the South African Nursing Council and hospital networks, welcomed the fee framework's equity focus but cautioned that affordability cannot be decoupled from workforce outcomes. If graduates are overburdened by debt without adequate placement, the pipeline weakens. Khanyisa's partnerships with public hospitals were designed to guarantee employment pathways, but regional disparities in hospital funding and staffing still limit graduate mobility.

Controversies and Criticisms: Access, Debt, and the Ethics of Nursing Education

Khanyisa's 2025 fees ignited heated debate across civil society. The South African Union of Students in Higher Education (SAUSE) condemned the R1.2 million figure as “a symbolic barrier for the poor,” noting that NSFAS grants, even with top-tier support, fell short of living cost benchmarks. Activists highlighted that mental health struggles among students—exacerbated by financial stress—led to higher dropout rates, particularly among first-generation learners. Conversely, critics from the private education sector argued that subsidized fees distorted market signals, potentially encouraging over-enrollment and lowering institutional accountability. Some economists warned that R60,000 in annual fees (even with subsidies) priced out a growing segment of the population, reinforcing class divides under the guise of equity. Clinicians within Khanyisa's network voiced dual concerns: while fee reductions for HDZ students supported long-term diversity, inconsistent fee structures across provinces created administrative complexity and raised equity concerns. A senior clinical instructor noted, “We train nurses to serve

communities, but our own pay scales lag behind. When our staff earn near-minimum wages, the moral foundation of our education is compromised.” The role of government accountability also came under scrutiny. While NSFAS funding was earmarked for access, there was no mandatory reporting on graduate employment rates or regional placement—key indicators of whether fees translated into meaningful workforce impact. Civil society groups demanded transparency, urging the Department of Health and Education to mandate annual public disclosures on Khanyisa’s graduate outcomes linked directly to fee policy.
