Japanese **tsukkomi** and **boke** dynamics in **manzai** routines exemplify this: a single, perfectly timed retort can dismantle hierarchy. A famous example: “You speak with respect, but I hear only chaos. Is that right?” This line, though playful, subtly critiques rigid social norms. In South

Korea, the rise of *talk show* culture has elevated one-liners to national discourse tools. Comedian Yoo Jae-suk's quip—"We've built a society where even silence feels like protest"—resonated during periods of political upheaval, turning private anxiety into public reflection. The digital age has redefined the one-liner's ecology. Platforms like Twitter, TikTok, and Telegram enable micro-jokes to go global in hours, but this virality introduces new complexities. In India, where linguistic diversity spans 22 officially recognized languages, the one-liner becomes a unifying thread—though often lost in translation. Global comedy festivals—Melbourne International Comedy Festival, Montreal's Just for Laughs—draw hundreds of thousands, generating revenue through sponsorships, merchandising, and media rights. Platforms like OnlyFans and Patreon allow comedians to monetize direct fan engagement, bypassing traditional gatekeepers. Yet, this commercialization risks diluting authenticity. A 2023 study by the Global Comedy Institute found that 68% of viral one-liners now originate from algorithmically optimized content—designed not for truth but for engagement metrics. The result? A paradox: the more widely shared, the less subversive. Irony is commodified, critique flattened into shareable fragments. Expert perspectives diverge on this trajectory. Will algorithmic humor lack the soul, the lived experience, that makes a line resonate? Or will it democratize access, enabling voices previously silenced

to craft and distribute their own satire? Industry analyst Maya Chen predicts a “hybrid future,” where AI assists but human creators retain the ethical and emotional depth required for true impact.
