7	How do you divide $(x^2 - 9)/(x + 4)$ by $(x - 3)/(x^2 - 16)$?	First, rewrite as multiplication by the reciprocal: $[(x^2 - 9)/(x + 4)] * [(x^2 - 16)/(x - 3)]$. Then factor: $((x-3)(x+3))/(x+4) * ((x-4)(x+4))/(x-3)$. Cancel common factors $(x-3)$ and $(x+4)$, leaving $(x+3)(x-4)$.

8	Why is factoring important when multiplying and dividing rational expressions?	Factoring helps identify common factors that can be canceled, simplifying the expression and making it easier to find restrictions and final simplified form.
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
