Iranian diaspora writers, for instance, use fanfiction to explore themes of freedom and identity forbidden in national discourse. Similarly, LGBTQ+ writers in conservative regions craft narratives that normalize queer existence within familiar fictional worlds, bypassing real-world repression through fictional sanctuary. Yet this narrative decentralization is not without friction. Western platforms often impose moderation policies rooted in Euro-American norms, leading to disproportionate censorship of

non-Western content. A 2023 study by the Digital Ethics Institute found that fanfiction from African and Southeast Asian writers was 3.7 times more likely to be flagged or removed than comparable works from Western creators—highlighting deep structural biases in automated content governance.

Expert Perspectives: From Academics to Industry Insiders

Scholars have increasingly recognized fanfiction not as cultural noise but as a legitimate site of literary and anthropological inquiry. Professor N.
