Its success hinges on three pillars: ethical AI design, adaptive governance, and continuous stakeholder engagement. During 2023 contract talks in several Western states, UFCW demanded transparency in algorithmic decision-making and limits on real-time monitoring, framing the issue as one of worker dignity, not just productivity.

Compounding these tensions was the platform's integration with performance metrics.
