California, by contrast, remains reactive—expanding Punjabi support only in response to litigation or advocacy pressure, rather than embedding multilingualism into its core testing architecture. From a geopolitical perspective, the Punjabi practice test embodies the complexities of transnational identity. Punjab, a region with deep historical and cultural ties to both India and the diaspora, represents a bridge between South Asia and North America. Systemic exclusion from effective testing undermines public safety. Drivers who pass under duress—without fully grasping test content—are statistically more likely to commit violations. A 2022 study in the *Journal of Transportation Safety* found that non-native English speakers with low test comprehension were 2.3 times more likely to fail safety-related questions, increasing accident risk. Thus, language access is not merely a civil rights issue but a public health
