Its framework resonates with post-Keynesian and heterodox traditions—particularly those emphasizing institutional context, historical contingency, and power asymmetry—yet it transcends disciplinary boundaries. In Latin America, where dependency theory once dominated, Saleemi's focus on local agency aligns with regional critiques of external debt and commodity dependence. In East Asia, his analysis of export-led growth and state-market coordination echoes

developmental state models, but with updated attention to digital platform capitalism. Comparatively, the project contrasts sharply with elite-centric economic discourse. While Goldman Sachs or IMF publications often prioritize technical jargon and forward-looking forecasts, *Economics Simplified* centers equity, historical injustice, and democratic accountability. This divergence mirrors a broader global divergence: between top-down, technocratic economic governance and bottom-up, participatory economic citizenship.

Long-Term Implications and Strategic Foresight

Looking ahead, the project's trajectory suggests several transformative possibilities. First, the fusion of economics and narrative journalism may become a new standard for public intellectuals. As AI-generated content floods digital spaces, Saleemi's human-centered, ethically grounded approach offers a counterweight—emphasizing empathy, context, and moral responsibility. Second, the initiative's modular, open-access model positions it as a cornerstone for global economic literacy. With translation into over 30 languages and partnerships with UNESCO and the United Nations Development Programme, *Economics Simplified* is scaling into a multilingual, multicultural educational infrastructure. This democratization of economic knowledge challenges the historical monopoly of Western academic institutions and fosters a more pluralistic understanding of development. Third, the project's emphasis on systemic fragility—climate risk, debt sustainability, and digital platform power—anticipates the next frontier of economic analysis. As climate-induced migration and AI-driven labor disruption accelerate, Saleemi's framework provides tools to diagnose not just what is happening, but why, and what choices remain. Finally, the enduring legacy of *Economics Simplified* will depend on its capacity to evolve. Saleemi has signaled plans to integrate real-

time data dashboards, interactive scenarios, and cross-cultural case studies, transforming static modules into dynamic learning environments.
