Economically, the horoscope has become intertwined with consumer culture. In Pakistan's informal economy, where formal employment is scarce, horoscopes offer a framework for risk assessment. Its viewership exceeds 2 million daily, reflecting a growing demand for astrology-infused content. Meanwhile, WhatsApp and Telegram groups run by astrologers distribute daily horoscopes in Urdu script, often personalized with birth details, creating a decentralized, hyper-local network of belief. This industry faces regulatory challenges. The SECP and Pakistan's National Commission for Human Rights have flagged fraudulent practices—such as astrologers charging for generic readings or making unverifiable claims about market movements. Yet enforcement remains weak, as astrology is deeply protected as part of religious and cultural freedom. This legal ambiguity fuels both innovation and exploitation, prompting calls for ethical guidelines without stifling tradition.

Global Parallels and Unique Trajectories

While astrology thrives globally, the Urdu horoscope occupies a distinct niche. In India, Vedic astrology shares structural similarities but lacks the same socio-political embedding—its practice is more individualized and less tied to national identity.
