In contrast, high-stakes testing environments like India’s CBSE system integrate adverbs drills into standardized drills, linking performance to school rankings.

In post-colonial contexts like Nigeria or Senegal, curriculum designers grapple with balancing global expectations with local linguistic identities—ensuring adverbs are taught in ways that honor native expression rather than enforcing foreign grammatical purity. While developed nations invest in adaptive, AI-enhanced digital workbooks, many developing regions rely on static, print-based materials.
