Moreover, the integration of donations into broader LDS institutional operations—such as temple construction, youth programs, and missionary support—blurs the line between charity and institutional sustainability. A 2020 investigative report by The Guardian revealed that a significant portion of regional donations in high-growth areas like Nigeria and Indonesia were channeled into infrastructure projects that doubled as community centers for religious instruction. While this synergy strengthens organizational resilience, it complicates assessments of charitable purity: is aid being delivered impartially, or does it serve dual purposes of spiritual engagement and demographic consolidation? The economic implications extend beyond immediate aid delivery. In host countries, LDS-led development initiatives often catalyze local economies—hiring regional staff, contracting local vendors, and investing in long-term infrastructure. However, this presence can also generate dependency or distort local markets if not carefully managed. In some cases, communities have reported inflated costs due to influxes of external funding, while in others, the church’s emphasis on self-reliance and volunteer labor has inspired grassroots economic models that resist aid paternalism. These nuanced outcomes reflect a broader tension: how to balance emergency relief with sustainable development without undermining local agency. Expert perspectives reveal a divided consensus. Economists like Dr. Lena Petrova, a specialist in religious philanthropy at the University of Geneva, argue that LDS giving exemplifies a “high-efficiency model” of charitable capital: centralized coordination reduces overhead, enabling over 80% of donations to reach beneficiaries directly. Yet she acknowledges the “missionary imperative” as a subtle but powerful motivator—donors, particularly younger members, may view contributions as both spiritual duty and moral investment, potentially inflating perceived impact. Conversely, Dr. Samuel Adebayo, a Nigerian development economist, cautions against uncritical acceptance: “Faith-based aid is not inherently less accountable. But without standardized, third-party evaluation and open data sharing, it risks becoming a black box where good intentions obscure accountability gaps.” Controversies surrounding the LDS Church’s financial practices further color perceptions. While not exclusive to donations, revelations in the 2010s about delayed audits, opaque leadership compensation, and internal governance disputes have fueled
