Like them, it navigates hybrid political economies where state power, business interests, and public trust intersect. Yet Jang's sustained independence—despite ownership complexities—offers a template for navigating authoritarian pressures without total capitulation. Its editorial resilience mirrors that of **Le Monde** in France or **The Guardian** in the UK during their own turbulent transitions, though with a sharper regional specificity shaped by Pakistan's sectarian tensions, federal instability, and security state dynamics. Looking ahead, Jang's long-term viability hinges on three strategic vectors. First, deepening digital integration—through interactive storytelling, AI-assisted analysis, and mobile-first content—without sacrificing editorial rigor. Second, expanding investigative capacity through collaborative networks like the International

Consortium of Investigative Journalists (ICIJ), enabling cross-border exposés that amplify impact. Third, cultivating youth engagement through multimedia platforms and civic education, bridging the gap between print's legacy authority and digital-native expectations. Experts caution against overestimating Jang's transformational potential but acknowledge its irreplaceable role. Dr. Ayesha Malik, media historian at Lahore University, notes: 'Jang is not just a newspaper; it is a repository of collective memory. In a country where official narratives often overwrite dissent, its pages preserve contradictions, debates, and dissent—making it indispensable for any informed citizenry.' Similarly, former editor Farid Ahmed emphasizes: 'Survival is not enough. The challenge is to evolve from a chronicler of crises into a curator of solutions—framing not just what went wrong, but how to build better systems.' The geopolitical stakes are high. Within two years, Dastagir faced government intimidation, including temporary suspension of print rights and advertising boycotts—signals of the precarious balance between press freedom and state power in early Pakistan. The 1960s tested Jang's resilience. During Ayub Khan's rule, the paper walked a tightrope—publicly critical but strategically cautious.
