Yet divergence persisted: Germany's TÜV certification system emphasized rigorous, state-audited practical exams; Japan integrated industry-led certification with corporate training consortia; China, amid rapid industrialization, adopted hybrid models blending national standards with multinational supply chain demands. Economic imperatives have shaped testing rigor. In low-cost labor markets, certification often remains minimal—driven by cost containment rather than safety culture. In contrast, high-wage economies like Germany and the Netherlands enforce multi-tiered testing: initial theoretical exams on physics, chemistry (e.g., battery safety), and ergonomics, followed by prolonged practical assessments under simulated stress conditions. These include navigating tight aisles, responding to emergency stops, and managing load shifts—scenarios requiring split-second judgment. The rise of e-commerce and last-mile delivery has amplified demand. Amazon's global warehouse network, for instance, mandates updated certification protocols incorporating drone coordination, automated dock systems, and cybersecurity awareness—extensions beyond traditional material handling.
