Yet the industry's growth was not without friction. In 2003, a whistleblower exposed irregularities in Arizona's ticket distribution, alleging that unregulated retailers in rural counties sold tickets on behalf of shell companies. The incident triggered statewide reforms: mandatory retailer licensing, GPS-tracked ticket

chains, and public databases of participating outlets. These measures, though costly, solidified Arizona's reputation for integrity—critical in a market where trust in randomness was fragile.
