This fragmentation was not just inconvenient; it exposed users to cascading risks: credential stuffing attacks, data breaches, and the loss of continuity across devices and locations. Simultaneously, governments and regulators worldwide began tightening digital sovereignty frameworks. The European Union’s General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) of 2018 set a precedent by asserting individual control over personal data. In China, the Personal Information Protection Law (PIPL) reinforced state-aligned models of data governance. These regulatory currents created fertile ground for identity solutions grounded in user sovereignty, not corporate monopolization. Uconnect, a multinational tech consortium formed in 2016 by a coalition of regional ISPs, fintech platforms, and telecom providers, recognized that a federated identity model—where users retain cryptographic control, yet gain seamless access—could satisfy both consumer demand and compliance.
