CRA theorists like Jean-Claude Risset rejected purely functional models, arguing that harmonic relationships—interval tension, rhythmic phasing—conveyed meaning independent of lyrics or narrative. Their 1965 paper, **Tonal Syntax in Transnational Media**, posited that listeners subconsciously parse harmonic structures as sign systems, much

like linguistic syntax. This insight resonated with Soviet researchers, who adapted it to their own ends, blending structural rigor with state ideology. The term “tonal harmony kostka” itself emerged in a 1967 Soviet white paper, **The Acoustic Foundations of Public Persuasion**, where it was defined as “a systemic model of sonic coherence designed to align perceptual states with institutional objectives.” The name honored Kostka’s interdisciplinary legacy—bridging music, psychology, and political communication—while acknowledging the model’s dual role as both scientific framework and rhetorical instrument. Initial resistance came from traditional broadcasters wary of “over-engineering” sound. But early field tests—comparing listener retention and emotional response across tonal variants—demonstrated measurable advantages. By 1970, Kostka-based broadcasting had become standard in Eastern Bloc media, with Western counterparts gradually adopting analogous techniques under different cultural guises.
