In contrast, the United States has long neglected its Arctic icebreaking capacity, relying on commercial icebreakers and foreign vessels—until recent legislative efforts to expand the fleet. Norway, a leader in Arctic research and shipping, integrates icebreaking into its green transition, using vessels to support offshore wind and scientific expeditions while monitoring ecosystem shifts. China's emergence as an "Arctic power" introduces a new dimension. Though not an Arctic state, Beijing has invested heavily in polar research and infrastructure, including icebreakers like *Xuelong 2*, which supports its Polar Silk Road initiative.
