To understand it is to confront the quiet architecture of displacement that underpins the modern world order. The origins of this condition stretch deep into the 20th century, yet its contemporary form is inseparable from the acceleration of transnational capitalism, the erosion of state sovereignty in crisis zones, and the commodification of human mobility. The League of Nations first formalized refugee protection in the aftermath of World War I, but the scale and complexity of forced and voluntary
