training programs elevated local medical education, producing generations of clinicians who would shape national health policy. Yet this growth coincided with broader economic crises: currency devaluations, reduced public spending, and the erosion of state capacity in the 1990s. During this period, controversies emerged over corruption allegations tied to procurement contracts and the diversion of funds, prompting parliamentary inquiries that temporarily destabilized leadership. The dawn of the 21st century brought both renewal and reckoning. A series of audits revealed systemic inefficiencies—overstaffing in underused departments, obsolete equipment, and inconsistent electronic health records. However, parallel to these challenges was a quiet renaissance: strategic partnerships with international NGOs, adoption of telemedicine platforms post-2010, and a renewed emphasis on community health outreach.
