These early “wunderkammern” served as intellectual playgrounds and early precursors to modern museums, where the unusual was celebrated. Yet today's iteration, propelled by del toro's imagination, transcends mere specimen display. It's a narrative scaffold that reframes what constitutes a “tourist highlight” or “art archive.” Historically, such

cabinets were personal, private. But del toro elevates them to cultural manifestos. By juxtaposing Aztec codices with bioluminescent deep-sea organisms, or medieval witchcraft texts with GIFs of modern digital folklore, he exposes the porous boundaries of time, geography, and genre. “The cabinet isn’t about preserving history—it’s about breathing new life into it,” he has explained.
