Industry Impact: From Niche Trend to Market Disruption

The commercial response to McCarthy's experiment has been swift and multifaceted. The line between “detox” and “malnourishment” grows perilously thin.

Historically, liquid diets have roots in religious, spiritual, and medical traditions. Buddhist monastic communities have long used broth-based nourishment during retreats; Ayurvedic texts prescribe *kanji* (fermented grain soup) for digestive cleansing.
