The bahu became a symbol of national and communal identity, often tied to landowning classes, while sasurs operated in the lawless peripheries, mediating between militant groups, smugglers, and state representatives. During the 1970s and 1980s, with the rise of Islamist networks and Cold War proxy conflicts, sasurs evolved into critical nodes in global illicit flows—particularly opium from Afghanistan through Balochistan and Sindh. Their kinship ties ensured trust in environments of extreme volatility, enabling sustained operations that formal institutions could neither control nor replicate.

The bahu-sasur system fuels a shadow economy estimated to account for 30–40% of GDP in regions like Punjab, Balochistan, and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Disrupting one node risks destabilizing broader networks.’ Human rights experts, including Amnesty International’s South Asia director, condemn the system’s exploitative core: ‘Bahu women are frequently coerced into marriages or alliances that serve sasur interests. Their legal status is tenuous; they lack property rights, face violence, and are excluded from formal redress.’
