The 2021 scandal involving a major edtech vendor—exposed for sharing unaggregated BYIST profiles with third-party advertisers—triggered regulatory crackdowns in the EU and California. Yet, despite these risks, investment continued to flow: venture capital into mental health analytics reached \$12.3 billion in 2024, with startups racing to "improve" the BYIST through machine learning, predictive modeling, and biometric integration. The tool's influence extended beyond software. Pharmaceutical companies, particularly those developing youth-targeted neuropsychiatric medications, adopted BYIST thresholds as clinical trial benchmarks.
