Critics, particularly from more ideologically driven think tanks, have accused it of elitism and undue influence—alleging that its close ties to government insulate it from public accountability. During the 2016 demonetization debate, internal memos revealed friction between Gokhale analysts advocating for phased, data-driven approaches and political leadership favoring rapid, symbolic action.
