In contrast, Scandinavian companies like Blinds & Co. in Sweden have pioneered closed-loop cleaning systems, using recycled water and biodegradable surfactants, aligning with regional sustainability mandates and consumer demand for ethical production. Controversies surround the industry’s labor practices and environmental footprint. Investigative reports from 2022 revealed sweatshop conditions in Indonesian factories where labor-intensive blind assembly coexists with minimal oversight. Meanwhile, the rise of “smart blinds”—equipped with motorized slats and IoT integration—has introduced digital vulnerabilities. A 2023 cybersecurity audit found that 40% of connected blind models transmit user data to cloud services without encryption, raising privacy concerns.
