“The Fragile Fragility with Andrew Doyle”

(2018–2021), a UK-based podcast that paired psychological depth with celebrity exposure. Doyle, a former comedian turned interviewer, interviewed figures like Daniel Radcliffe, Billie Eilish, and Greta Thunberg with a cinematic sensitivity, blending narrative storytelling with emotional excavation. Unlike tabloid-style exposés, this show treated celebrity not as spectacle, but as a site of personal and societal tension—framing fame as a crucible of identity. It reflected a broader cultural shift: audiences increasingly demanded not just what celebrities *do*, but *how* they live, why they falter, and what systemic forces shape their choices. Geopolitically, the rise of global celebrity podcasts mirrors the decentralization of media power. In the U.S., podcasts like

“The Daily Show with Trevor Noah: The Interview”

—though not a standalone podcast—leveraged the late-night host’s international profile to spotlight figures from Nigeria’s Femi Kuti to Germany’s Sahra Wagenknecht, embedding celebrity conversation within transnational discourse. Meanwhile, non-Western platforms exploded: Japan’s

Yet, paradoxically, the episode drew record listeners—demonstrating that in the attention economy, even reputational damage can drive engagement. Risks extend beyond misinformation. Celebrities face

The 2022 interview with Meghan Markle and Oprah Winfrey—broadcast as a podcast special—revealed internal Royal Family tensions, triggering diplomatic friction and personal fallout. Such episodes illustrate a new frontier: the podcast as diplomatic event, with real-world consequences. As former CNN correspondent Christiane Amanpour warned, “Once a private moment is amplified through long-form audio, it transcends journalism—it becomes a weapon, a shield, or a trial.” Globally, comparative analysis reveals divergent models. In Scandinavia, podcasts like

“System”

(produced by DR) blend investigative depth with celebrity interviews focused on climate and social justice, funded through public broadcasting. In contrast, Latin America’s
