The cask's design—staves bound with iron hoops, watertight seams—was not accidental but engineered to withstand transcontinental trade: Roman amphorae gave way, but it was the cask's durability and scalability that enabled the rise of transatlantic spirits commerce. Yet within this utility lay a latent danger: the sealed vessel, once opened, could become a weapon—of pressure, of containment, or of surprise in conflict.
