It became a platform for improvisation—customized with stolen parts, painted with family crests, modified to carry equipment, or stripped down for fuel efficiency in regions where gas was rationed or unaffordable.

For young men like my papi, ownership was not about status but utility—a tool to commute, deliver goods, or support a family. Yet this very accessibility fuels a shadow economy: unregistered vehicles, unreported income from transport work, and tax evasion that strains public budgets. Globally, the industry faces seismic shifts. Electrification is gaining traction, but in Latin America, battery infrastructure remains sparse. Lithium-rich nations like Chile and Argentina are positioning themselves as future battery hubs, yet the transition to electric motorcycles is hindered by cost, charging deserts, and reliance on imported lithium-ion components. My papi’s gas-powered CB350, then, is both anachronistic and resilient—a relic of a transitional era, embodying the tension between legacy mobility and the green imperative.

While my papi’s bike is not involved in crime,
