In contrast, in authoritarian regimes, Cenicienta's message is often suppressed—viewed as subversive due to

its implicit critique of inherited power. Recent adaptations, such as the 2021 **Cinderella** by Blitz Bazawule (a Ghanaian-Nigerian production), center Black girlhood, redefining magic as ancestral knowledge, the slipper as a symbol of cultural continuity. This evolution reflects a broader shift: narratives must adapt not only to survive, but to speak truth to power. Looking forward, the future of *Cenicienta* lies in its malleability.
