He sought not mere background music, but a narrative voice that could carry the film's emotional core between battle and quiet reflection. The lyricist's task was not to narrate but to evoke: "a lament not for death, but for what is lost in movement." This reframing aligned with the trilogy's central theme—home as both a place and a

feeling—while responding to late-1990s anxieties about cultural displacement. The global release of **The Lord of the Rings** (2001–2003) coincided with rising migration, digital connectivity, and a renewed scholarly interest in indigenous narratives—forces that **Into the West** unwittingly amplified. Clark argues that Jackson’s portrayal of Middle-earth’s vastness, narrated through a voice of quiet despair, subtly critiques colonial hubris, even as it sells a mythic escape.
